Dear :

You were previously sent a Termination and Notice to Vacate letter dated February 10, 2020 (Termination Letter). The Termination Letter provided that the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports Division (DOTA) had decided to terminate its lease with the U.S. Army. Accordingly, you were notified that Revocable Permit No. _____ (RP-) would be terminated as of June 30, 2020.

The COVID-19 crisis has put a hold on DOTA's efforts to terminate the lease with the U.S. Army, and the closing of Kawaihapai Airfield has been delayed. The Termination Letter that you received is rescinded. Please be advised that DOTA is still working to terminate its lease with the U.S. Army. DOTA's goal is to do so by June 30, 2021. We expect that all parking and/or revocable permits would be terminated by that date at the latest. You may wish to use this additional time to make alternative arrangements. In the meantime, all terms, conditions, and requirements of RP-_____ remain in effect.
