SUBJECT: UPDATE OF DILLINGHAM AIRFIELD ARMY LEASE TERMINATION

You were previously sent a Termination and Notice to Vacate Letter dated February 10, 2020 (Termination Letter), notifying you that the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports Division (DOTA) had decided to terminate its lease of Kawaihapai f/k/a Dillingham Airfield (HDH or Airfield), effective June 30, 2020. Accordingly, you were notified that DOTA would terminate all parking and revocable permits as of June 30, 2020.

On April 8, 2020, you were sent a letter indicating that the termination date of DOTA's HDH lease was postponed until June 30, 2021.

On April 29, 2021, you were sent a letter indicating that the termination date was further postponed until December 31, 2021.

As you know, DOTA is currently negotiating the terms of its underlying lease with the U.S. Army in order to determine whether it is possible to address DOTA's ongoing legal concerns with the terms of its lease. In light of some recent progress on securing a Joint Use Agreement and a new, long-term lease with the Army, DOTA rescinded the termination of its lease with the Army on September 17, 2021. **Therefore, the purpose of this letter is to formally rescind DOTA's prior notice of termination for your permit**. However, it is important for you to understand that DOTA reserves its continuing right to early termination of the Army lease if the Army does not make continued and timely progress on resolving the legal issues and issuing a new Joint Use Agreement and long-term lease. In such case, DOTA will provide you appropriate notification regarding the effect on your permit.

As a result of DOTA's decision to rescind the termination of its lease with the Army, your Parking Permit No. PP-_____ will remain in effect on a month-to-month basis as provided under the terms set forth in the permit. All terms, conditions, and requirements of your permit remain in effect.
