Goal: Clean and refresh airport

DOT sponsored event accepted bulky furniture, appliances, air conditioners, paper, plastic, electronics, tires and other difficult to dispose of items.

Waste collected is responsibly disposed of by re-use, recycle, H-Power and if neccessary landfill.

The event saves tenants thousands of dollars in disposal costs annually.

Special thanks go out to the DOT Oahu District Maintenance Baseyard team who provided staff and a forklift to the event to help unload the waste.

Additional thanks go to the haulers West Oahu Aggregate and First Onsite, who hauled the waste away, leaving the airport cleaner than before. Estimated <u>Materials</u> **90** cubic yards of metals


